
How to Make a Square from Rectangular Paper


Step 1

Lay your rectangular paper flat.




Step 2

Fold one corner down until it reaches the opposite edge. You should know have a shape that looks like a triangle with a long skinny rectangle attached.




Step 3

Flip the paper over.




Step 4

Fold the section of the paper that isn't part of the triangle so that it overlaps the triangular part of the paper.



Step 5

Open up the fold.



Step 6

Using the crease you just created as a guide,


cut off rectangular section of the paper from the triangular section of the paper.



Step 7

Once you have cut off the rectangle, discard.

(Or save for a different art project!)





Unfold the triangle, and you now have a square!
